donate twice. Also awaiting for the grant from the government so families can be assured the pavers will be going ahead as soon as the hall has been completed.

Mother's Day and Father's Day stall – the mother's day stall for this year is going to go ahead but unfortunately the Father's Day stall at this stage will not be going ahead. The support for the Mother's Day stall has not been as well received as it had been last year. A few complaints from parents in regards to the gifts their children had chosen or were given. Place a note in the newsletter to ask for help on the day for the Mother's Day stall on Thursday the 7th of May 2009.

(Discussion) Working bee – Sunday the 17th of May 2009. Place a request in the newsletter for the parents to help at the working bee. Some of the work to be done is as follows; gardening, putting pavers down and painting walls or touching up paint on areas that need to be done. Make a mud / dirt patch so kids can mix rocks, bark etc and not have it in the sand pit. Make a track for the kids to use for their cars in one of the gardens.

(Discussion) RE – Struggling to have time for the lessons. Time frames are not working in with all teachers due to music, library and general class room activities. The children who do not wish to be involved in RE need to be supervised in a separate room. More children are opting out of RE. To look at offering different religions to the students. Offer the students life skills (values).
